

PAST PERFECT SIMPLE and CONTINUOUS (unit 3)

1. Simple: HAD + PARTICIPLE

- Talking about sth which happened before sth which is described in the past simple
 When he got to the station , his train had already left
 - (When he got to the station, his train had already left
- Typically with time expressions (conjunctions) such as: when, as soon as, after, before....
 - She started driving before she had fastened her seatbelt
- Often with these adverbs: already, just, never....
 He had never eaten liver and kidney pie until he came to England.

2. Continuous: HAD + BEEN + -ING

- Same as past perfect simple: `....sth which happened before sthdescribed in the past simple ...' BUT:
 - Focuses on the length of time:
 Mandy needed a rest because she had been working the whole day
 - Says how long sth happened up to a point in the past:

 He had been playing for Arsenal for only two games when he scored his first goal (llevaba ... `x´ tiempo `haciendo algo´
